Aerlinte Eireann PLC understands that upon conviction in this matter, it may not receive a license to export items on the U.S. Munitions List (USML), or be a party to an export of an item on the USML, except as may be determined in accordance with §38(g)(4) of the Arms Export Control Act, 22 U.S.C. §38(g)(4) and §127.6 (statutory debarment) and §127.10 (past violations) of the ITAR. If Aerlinte Eireann PLC seeks an exception from its statutory debarment or ineligibility, the Department of Justice has agreed to bring appropriate facts relating to this matter to the attention of the Office of Munitions Control, Department of State.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me by §127.9 of the ITAR, it is


ORDERED

A civil penalty in the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS is imposed on Aerlinte Eireann PLC, to be paid within ten days of the time of sentencing by wire transfer, cashier's check or certified check made payable to the Department of State.


