

Effective December 30, 2014, DDTC will make a slight change to the DTrade submission requirements for certain subparagraphs within USML Category XI. Due to the unique nature of USML Category XI and the specificity of USML control parameters within this category, some additional subparagraphs will require identification of sub-subparagraphs. (A sub-subparagraph is a section that includes a Roman numeral, e.g., Category XI(a)(3)(v)). If a defense article meets the criteria for multiple sub-subparagraphs, the applicant should: a) choose the single predominant sub-subparagraph, based on the nature of the item, as the primary entry in the "USML Category" block; and b) identify the other relevant sub-subparagraphs in both the "Commodity" block and in the supporting documentation. Applicants are advised that incorrect entries to the "USML Category" block may result in the submission being "Returned Without Action" (RWA). Moreover, RWA may be delayed in certain cases since the incorrect identification of a sub-subparagraph may not be detected until after the technical review is complete.
